1. MENTORING

Our aim is to ensure that every Chamber President, Deputy President, Regional Group Chairman and member of National Board has a personal mentor (if they are happy to have one). We are appointing some joint JCI UK / British Senate representatives to co-ordinate the mentoring programme and they will be there to provide you with any information that mentors might need.
