SCANDIC SØRLANDET

Scandic Sørlandet in Kristiansand is one of the region's largest conference hotels and we organize everything from small day meetings to larger national meetings and conferences. And if you want an active family stay, we have, among other things, Dyreparken as our nearest neighbour.

The hotel is within walking distance of Norway's largest shopping centre, Sørlandssenteret, with shops and activities such as go-karts and a playground. We are located 15 minutes east of the center of Kristiansand and 10 minutes from the airport. There is free parking (subject to availability) right outside the hotel, with space for 165 cars. There are also frequent bus departures to the center of Kristiansand

The hotel offers 210 beautiful rooms with space for over 700 people. We have a state-of-the-art fitness room that can be used free of charge by all our guests. In our beautiful garden, we have a large heated swimming pool with associated pool bar, which is open during the summer season. We advertise on our Facebook page when the pool is open. The hotel has large outdoor areas, a beach volleyball court and an à la carte restaurant with many tasty dishes for young and old.



The Tangen collection consists of over 5,000 works, and is referred to as the largest and most important collection of Nordic modernist art from the period 1910–1990.

The collection's main focus on Nordic modernism makes it unique in a world context, and includes paintings, graphics, sculptures, textile works, ceramics, handicrafts, photography and conceptual art.

Unique to the collection is that it goes in-depth with great, well-known artists such as Reidar Aulie, Asger Jorn, Lars-Gunnar Nordström and Anna-Eva Bergman. In addition, important work has been done to collect works from artists who have been passed over by history. Part of the strategy has been to select artistry based on Nicolai Tangen's personal preferences and interests, and which he has wanted to explore in depth.

The wide spectrum of art provides almost endless possibilities for creating a rich program with changing exhibitions around theme and artistry.
